## Venue

COMMUNITY PARK POOL

In Princeton on Witherspoon St at Valley Rd, near Route 206 & Cherry Hill Rd

The facilities include changing areas, an Olympic sized pool, a wading pool, and a separate diving pool with two 1-meter springboards and a 3-meter board.

There will be a cash concession stand serving hot and cold food all day, as well as vendors selling T-shirts and swim & dive accessories.

## Warm-ups

Divers may practice their dives the night before the event, early in the morning the day of the event, and again, for just a few minutes, before their age-group begins.

## Events & Awards

Divers may dive in two events: their age-specific group and/or one OPEN event. Divers may only "dive-up" in age for an OPEN event. There are no "B" events as there are in regular season dual meets. Either of the 1-meter boards may be used by a diver during an event unless otherwise specified by meet officials. Divers age 6 & under will have separate events that will run concurrently with the 8 & under events. The 6/u events will score points separately from u/8 events.

Events 1 & 2: 14/u Girls and Boys	Events 7 & 8: 6/u and 8/u Boys
Events 3 & 4: 18/u Girls and Boys	Events 9 & 19: 6/u and 8/u Girls
Events 5 & 6: 18/u OPEN Girls and Boys	Events 11 & 12: 10/u Girls and Boys
	Events 13 & 14: 12/u Girls and Boys
	Events 15 & 16: 12/u OPEN Girls and Boys

The individual winner of each event will be awarded a trophy. Places 2 through 8 will receive medals, and places 9 through 16 will receive ribbons. Team trophies will be awarded to division winners of Dual Meet season and teams finishing first through third at Championships.

## Event Requirements

<b>Event</b>	<b>Championship Requirements</b>	<b>Max Age as of June 1</b>
6 & Under*	101 or front line-up plus 100 and 200	6
8 & Under*	101 plus 100 and 200 (or a jump and a dive)	8
10 & Under*	101 plus 1 jump and 1 dive (or 2 dives)	10
12 & Under	3 dives covering 2 groups, 101 required	12
12/u OPEN	5 dives: 2 voluntaries covering 2 groups 3 optionals covering 3 groups	12
14 & Under	4 dives covering 3 groups, 101 required	14
18 & Under	5 dives covering 3 groups, 101 required	18**
18/u OPEN	8 dives: 4 voluntaries covering 4 groups 4 optionals covering 4 groups	18**

\* Degree of Difficulty (DD) is 1.0 for all 6 & under dives, and correct DD is applied to all 8 & under dives. Jumps and line-ups have a DD of 1.0. Both 6/u and 8/u may balk twice without penalty. No jumps allowed at 12/u, 14/u, and 18/u.

For the two OPEN events (12/u and 18/u): voluntary dives must be completed first with their true degree of difficulty, followed by the optional dives. Voluntary dives must have a lower dive number than optional dives in the same category. Two failed dives will put a competitor out of the competition.

## **Entries & Fees**

Entries should be delivered electronically by the team coach a week before the meet (see link at [www.pasda.org](http://www.pasda.org) under diving). Entries must be finalized 2 days before the meet. No participants may be added the day of the meet, but dives may be altered up to 30 minutes before the diver's event is scheduled. Coaches are responsible for verifying accuracy of entries. Please be sure each participant's dive order is correct.

Fees are \$10 per event for each diver. Payments should be collected by the Team Rep. A single check made out to PASDA is due before the meet begins.

## **Eligibility**

Diver's age as of June 1 will determine age for the entire PASDA season including championship meet. Bona fide PASDA divers are eligible to compete if they are on the submitted team roster, and they have competed in at least 1 dual meet during the season. Divers who are 18 may compete in 18 & under so long as they just graduated or are still in high school.

## **Judging & Announcing**

Since 2005, we have required coaches to serve as judges and announcers. We intend to continue this practice this year. We will continue to include a sixth judge, so that in no case will a coach be scoring their own diver. The intent is to have consistency, impartiality, and high quality. Non-coaches will be considered for announcing and judging if needed. A PASDA official will be the meet referee.

## **Scoring & Results**

Team scores will be tallied by division and overall. Each event allows points for top 16 finishes as follows: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1. Individual awards will be given shortly after each age group; team awards at the end of the day. Final results will be posted on the Internet (see link on [www.pasda.org](http://www.pasda.org) under diving).

## **Fundraising Host – Nassau**

- Coordinates photographer for event (including back-up)
- Distributes information for ordering participant photos
- Collects funds, report totals, and manages all photo related issues.

- Coordinate vendors for Swim Accessories, T-shirts, and Clothing

## **Hospitality Host – TBD**

- Ensures adequate supplies of water are available to all judges, scorers, and meet administrators during the day, as well as coffee in the morning.
- Provide simple box lunch for judges, scorers, and meet administrators or use on-site snack bar by pre-arrangement. PASDA will reimburse expenses.
